Regulations 2008

1. Championship/Cup

This is regulations for:

North European Zone Ferrari Scandinavia Challenge Cup

Short: FSC Cup.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

The 2008 Scandinavia Championship/Cup is handled by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with the respective countries Circuit racing committees or their representatives in the FIA North European Zone. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from each ASNs and Organizing Club's.

Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

FIA Nez Racing Commission representatives together as a voting body has the right to grant some racing vehicles with additional technical requirements or additional weight if needed.

3. Eligible Drivers

The Events will be National and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid license, including permission from their respective ASN.

Only drivers with a license issued of a NEZ-country can score points in the Championship/Cup.

4. Eligible Cars

Cars must fulfill requirements of Technical Regulations for FSC 2008.

Noise level according to each event Supplementary Regulations.

5. Championship Single Event

6. Points

The points will be given for two classes Challenge and Trofeo 360.

Drivers who pass scrutinizing and participate in the timed practice will be counted as having started.

Points will be awarded to Competitors listed as classified race finishers (completed at least 75 % of race distance) in the results for each race according to the following scale.

All points scored will be added to determine the overall position.

If FIA General Rules does not split drivers with equal points, the following will apply: The final order of drivers who scored equal points will be determined based on the order the respective drivers finished in the last race they met.

7. Entries

The NEZ Cup event is open for all drivers regardless if they are considered as Championship drivers or guest drivers in the FSC Championship. The application and payment must be submitted to FSC at the date stipulated in the coming invitation. As usual two drivers can share a car during the event. They will have the same competition number, but each driver has his own transponder.

8. Race Numbers and advertising

Each car will carry the race number of its driver(s). Competition numbers will be given by FSC. Competition numbers are the same as those of the FSC Championship.

The Family name and nationality (Flag) must be placed on the side windows on both sides of each car. The letters must be 7.5 cm high as a minimum.

9. Free Practice, Qualifying and Race

According to the event-organizer's time schedule.

2 races - weekend (event) with a duration of 15 minutes – 120 minutes.

Grid positions for race 1 will be determined from the fastest lap recorded by drivers during official qualifying.

Grid positions for race 2 will be according event Supplementary Regulation.

Rolling start will be used because of safety reasons

Race 2 may be an endurance race with stops for refueling..

False start will be penalized according event Supplementary Regulations.

10. Fuel

According to the technical regulations.

11. Tire Limitation

Competitor may use for each event (including official qualifying and two races) not more than 2 set new or used slick/dry-tires.

Wet-tires are free.

12. Time-keeping

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder mounted and working when the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and race).

13. NEZ Racing Commission representatives:

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
